October is a time when we reflect on our commitment to our parish through our stewardship. We are stewards, not masters, of God's gifts. There are so many ways in which to give of yourself in service of our parish mission. Pope Francis says that we cannot be indifferent to the needs around us. We will also focus on developing legacy giving in the month of November. Gifts from the past have assisted us with some major capital improvements. Presently, we have had to undertake some work on the church steeple. The wind was blowing off some of the wooden finials which created a hazard for people walking by. We have an opportunity through an anonymous gift to match up to \$25,000 to assist us in covering this expense. If you are able to make a contribution, place the money in an envelope marked for the 'matching grant' and put it in the collection.

Stewardship is not only about treasure, it also entails time and talent. We will have an opportunity in the coming week to indicate how we would like to be involved personally in the life of the parish. Please begin reflecting and praying now to discern what God is calling you to do.
