My Friends,

You may have noticed that we haven't taken up a collection for our *Home for a Season* recently. It is with regret that I inform you it was the decision of the board to suspend this ministry. Last fall, we had the opportunity to provide transitional housing for women who were a step away from being on the streets. The idea was to support them so that they could establish themselves and eventually get an apartment on their own. We were able to rent a house with three bedrooms. It was our hope that we could house three residents and mentor them along the way. We had no permanent person to take charge of running the house. We were in no position financially to hire someone to assume this responsibility. Unfortunately, when it became impossible to carry out our mission, we decided to suspend the ministry.

Thanks to your generosity, we still have money left in the account given for this ministry. I intend to use it to assist the homeless. There is a hope among all the members of the Elyria Ministerial Association to open a house for men. In celebration of Elyria's bicentennial year in 2017, the various churches in the area are working to establish Elyria as a Compassionate City. It is an international movement based on Karen Armstrong's book, *Twelve Steps to a Compassionate Life*. It is a hope of the EMA to provide some kind of assistance for the homeless as part of our inaugurating this movement in our city. I will keep you updated on the progress of this project.

Next weekend, Fr. Joseph Pednekar will give our annual Mission appeal for the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales, India. I ask your generous support of the work the missionaries carry out in India.
