My Friends,

In this month of October, we continue to reflect on the stewardship of our time, talent and treasure in service of furthering the mission of God's Kingdom. We have had the annual finance report and Angie Pluta's 5-year plan for the continued success of our school. In these coming weeks, we need to address our commitment to the mission of our parish and school.

Next weekend we will once again fill out our commitment form for the coming year. Under the area of treasure we hope that you would consider an increase in your Offertory giving. We pointed out in the report that last year we ran a \$40,000 deficit in our operating expenses. We would need a 7% increase in the Offertory collection to meet our budget needs in the coming year. Everyone's financial situation is different. Whatever you can do to help us in this need would be very much appreciated.

Many of you received a mailing from *Faith Direct* inviting you to enroll in electronic giving. This is how I make my contribution. So many today are doing their finances electronically. This is a convenient option for those who are comfortable working with a computer. When you enroll, you have complete control of your account and can indicate the amounts you would like to give in the second collection. It also makes our bookkeeping much easier. Forms to enroll are in today's bulletin.

To address the question of the deficit, we have the opportunity once again to double your gift to the church through a matching grant up to \$25,000. Last year, we only took advantage of the grant for \$13,000. This will be available until the end of the year. When you make your contribution, please write 'matching grant' on your check or envelope. Hopefully, we will be able to take advantage of the full \$25,000. Thank you in advance for anything that you can do to help us meet our financial obligations.
