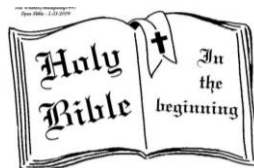

<p>Monday March 2</p>	<p>“Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful...”</p> <p>Reflect on the Gospel of Luke 6:36-38</p> <p>Help me to show mercy on all those with whom I come in contact today.</p>
<p>Tuesday March 3</p>	<p>“For they preach but they do not practice...”</p> <p>Reflect on the Gospel of Matthew 23:1-12</p> <p>Saying the right thing is easy, today let me be an example of doing what is right.</p>
<p>Wednesday March 4</p>	<p>“...whoever wishes to be great among you shall be your servant; whoever wishes to be first among you shall be your slave.”</p> <p>Reflect on the Gospel of Matthew 20:17-28</p> <p>Being a slave or servant does not seem to be a great thing but you have shown us that this is the way to follow you.</p>
<p>Thursday March 5</p>	<p>“If they will not listen to Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded if someone should rise from the dead.”</p> <p>Reflect on the Gospel of Luke 16:19-31</p> <p>Help me to listen to your word from scripture and as you speak in my everyday life.</p>
<p>Friday March 6</p>	<p>“The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone; by the Lord has this been done, and it is wonderful in our eyes?”</p> <p>Reflect on the Gospel of Matthew 21:33-43, 45-46</p> <p>Let me understand the marvelous things you have done and not turn away from you.</p>
<p>Saturday March 7</p>	<p>“Quickly, bring the finest robe and put it on him; put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet.”</p> <p>Reflect on the Gospel of Luke 15:1-3, 11-32</p> <p>You have given us an example of forgiveness may I be open to complete forgiveness of others.</p>
