My Friends,

Inserted in this week's bulletin is the latest update on the diocesan *Rooted in Faith – Forward in Hope* campaign. If you remember when we made our pledges 3 years ago, there were 5 major distributions to be made from the money collected. A major portion went to Catholic education to assist with tuition and school capital improvements. This past year we received a \$20,000 grant to purchase 30 ipads to be used by our students. This year, we have filed for additional grants and have received \$10,000 in tuition assistance. A portion of the money goes to the priest retirement fund. Close to \$15 million has been directed to the fund thus lowering our yearly contribution as a parish to the fund.

Finally, you may remember that 30% of the money collected was returned to the parish. The new carpeting in the church was paid for through this funding. To date, we have received over \$60,000 in the RIF payments to the parish. As we are approaching our goal, 70% of the money collected will be returned to the parish. Presently, we have some capital improvements we need to make on the church and some work on the parish hall. Your continued support of RIF is truly a gift not only to our diocesan family, but also to our parish family. I truly appreciate your generous support to our parish life. It certainly makes my life a lot easier when we have the money to pay our bills.

On another note, I hope we will see some of our teens at the parish hall this Sunday evening. We have game night with volleyball and/or basketball. We will also have board games available. These social events are a way to get to know one another as we strive to create an active community of our teens. Bring a friend and come join us.
