My Friends,

Known in the olden days as the Feast of Corpus Christi, we celebrate the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. I think it is appropriate that it follows Holy Trinity Sunday as it is the means that we enter into the community of life shared by Father, Son and Holy Spirit. In the commingling of Christ's Body and Blood with our own, we are drawn into 'common-union' with Jesus. Filled with his Spirit we too cry 'Abba' to God our Father. If we could only begin to comprehend the depth of this mystery, would we be so halfhearted about our attendance and participation at Sunday Mass!

This Sunday gives us a chance to reflect on our Eucharistic devotion. What is our motivation for attending Mass? Is it simply to punch the time clock to keep God happy? God does not impose himself as an obligation. Rather he offers us the opportunity to deepen the bond of love that takes us into himself. It is God who desires our love and we respond to his invitation with indifference. I have a feeling it is due to our own lack of awareness. This is why I encourage you to reflect on your devotion as you come to church. We must prepare ourselves to enter into the mystery. I believe the mindset and the way we dress and behave all impact the meaning we will find in the Eucharist.

If we dress like we are going to the gym that will be the attitude we bring to Mass. I'm sure God does not care what we wear, but what about the people around you who are trying to pray? Are we a distraction to their prayer? I do not believe in cry rooms in churches, but if a child is fussing over a period of time, why not walk them around the back of church? Again, the question to be asked is whether the people around you are able to pray.

Finally, I would encourage you to do some prep work before you come. We have booklets with the Sunday readings. Read them ahead of time with the commentary. On Thursdays from 9am to 5pm we have Eucharistic Devotion in the lower chapel. Come spend some time to deepen your relationship with the Lord in the Eucharist. Do yourself a favor and come up with your own personal resolution to deepen your love for the Lord in the Eucharist.
