My Friends,

As we are reminded to respect and cherish the dignity of life in this month of October, I must begin by thanking you for your generous response to last week's questionnaire. I was truly gratified by your willingness to offer your assistance to people in need. This will be a blessing for our parish.

Many of you indicated that you would like to support our efforts in providing housing to the homeless. This is where we can get really creative. At this point in time, we will rent a house to provide shelter for a couple of women at a time. We will work with them to get them established and self-sufficient. This will include mentoring, helping them develop basic skills like budgeting or parenting, at times offering a ride and just giving them personal support. Our school children are collecting toiletries as their contribution to the effort. We had over 100 returns so it will take a little time to make all of the calls. You will be able to indicate your interest at that time.

Looking to the future, we are hoping that we will also be able to operate a house for men. Again, this is not meant to be a permanent residence. Our purpose is to give them a solid footing so that they can take a step up and be on their own. We will keep you updated as things progress.

I know that Maryann Ketchesin and Dottie Knechtges have managed our social outreach programs for centuries. It is time for new people to step up and assist them. Not only do they organize our Tuesday night Hot Meals, but also cook a Sunday night meal for the Salvation Army and a meal once a month for the St. Joseph homeless shelter. They need nurses to assist with the Sunday morning blood pressure checks. We also need some new blood on our Social Concerns Commission. Your response last weekend has given me a lot of hope for our future ministry. Pope Francis would be proud!
