St. Mary School, a fully accredited institution, will celebrate Catholic Schools Week Jan. 31st - Feb. 5th. We will begin the week by hosting an **Open House** on Sunday, **January 31, 2016** from 10:30am to 1:00pm. All are invited to attend, especially those considering the education of their children. Come meet our teachers, tour our buildings and learn about our challenging curriculum in a Christ-centered environment. Our school enrolls children in kindergarten - grade 8. We also offer a half and full day preschool program for 3 and 4 year olds.

Registration for the 2016-2017 school year for Preschool, Kindergarten and NEW students to St. Mary School will begin Sunday, Jan. 31st, from 10:30am-1pm during our School Open House. Registration will take place in the school office. Students new to St. Mary School must bring the following documentation: Birth Certificate, Baptismal Certificate (if not Baptized at St. Mary), Records of First Communion and First Reconciliation (if applicable), Immunization records, Legal custody papers (if applicable) and Registration fee of \$150 [\$50 at time of registration on or before Mar. 8th with remainder due May 16th - nonrefundable - Registration fee increases to \$200 if down payment not made by 3/8/16.] A student registering for Kindergarten must be 5 years old by September 30, 2016. Registration will be considered complete when Parish registration has been verified and the school office has received all materials and fees.
