My Friends,

Recently you should have received a mailing from the diocese in celebration of this Year of Mercy. (If not, there are extra copies at the church entrances.) It is an invitation to go on pilgrimage in this jubilee year. It is structured like a 'passport' titled 'Love Hopes & Bears All Things.' As you journey through the year, you will receive stamps for the various projects that you fulfill.

There are 2 official Holy Doors for this jubilee celebration. There is one at St. John's Cathedral and the other is Our Lady of Lourdes National Shrine on Chardon Road in Euclid. Entering through a 'holy door' signifies the deep desire for true conversion. The various 'stops' on this jubilee pilgrimage are the corporal and spiritual works of mercy. The passport provides the opportunity for you to perform a work of mercy and then journal about it. The passport would be a wonderful way for a family to deepen their spirituality and grow in their faith. There are ways to participate in the pilgrimage even if you are unable to leave your home.

The jubilee year is a good way to prepare for our celebration of Elyria's bicentennial next year. There is an international movement that promotes 'Compassionate Cities.' We made an initial attempt to take on this project a couple of years ago. Now we are encouraging the Elyria churches to come together as we seek to build this wider community. It would be a great follow-up to our Year of Mercy.

One of the difficulties in promoting our various efforts is getting the word out. I hope you are receiving our weekly emails. There is so much information about what is going on around the parish. The diocese also has a magazine that you will receive in the mail 6 times a year. But it also has an email blast that goes out every Thursday with diocesan news. 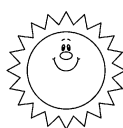
