My Friends,

As the school year quickly comes to an end, we congratulate all of our First Communicants. It is a time of grace for our whole parish as we welcome our children to the Eucharistic feast. The point of our gathering is to draw us together as a parish family. It is Jesus who invites us to come together in the bond of His love. We need one another to make His love come alive. Celebrating our children's First Communion reminds us of the blessing that is ours. May we all grow deeper together in His love.

We may be at the end of one school year but it is time to begin planning for our new school year. Thanks to the generosity of our parishioners, we have been able to assist our families with student tuition. In the past year, we awarded over \$50,000 to help parents send their children here to St. Mary's School. It is our hope to continue this assistance. We are able to award \$30,000 in grants from our parish endowment. Last year, some of our families received money from a \$10,000 grant from the diocesan school endowment.

An important means of support has been our Sponsor-a-Student program. We have been able to award close to \$20,000 in tuition assistance. Our monthly second collection helps fill in the gaps. We are presently making our awards and once again seek your support for our Sponsor-a-Student program. The cost of tuition this year remains at \$2,850. If you are able to assist with any part of that, your generosity would be much appreciated. It takes a village to raise a child and this is what makes us family. Any support that you can give to this endeavor should be sent directly to me.

Finally, our parish Pastoral Council is in the process of discerning new members. We are open to anyone who might feel called to serve on the council. If you have an interest, please let the office know within the next two weeks.
